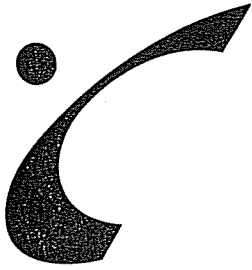

**JOB SUMMARY:** Reports, researches and writes daily news stories and long-form reports for WNPR programs; anchors daily news magazine program (*All Things Considered*); serves as “swing editor” —preparing content for afternoon and morning newscasts and website, provides WNPR listeners and web viewers with freshest and most up-to-date news and information.

This position requires an experienced “senior-level” reporter with excellent news judgment, to work with News Director and Senior Editor to set news coverage priorities; will work with national and regional news partners to create content; will play a leadership role in the WNPR newsroom.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Generates ideas and produces daily news coverage for WNPR’s *All Things Considered* and *Morning Edition*, including the reporting, writing, and editing of short-form news spots, quick turnaround reporter debriefs and 2-ways, and long-form reports and interviews.
- Serves as afternoon news anchor during WNPR’s *All Things Considered* (4 to 7 p.m.)
- Produce, edit and oversee YourPublicMedia.org news report (1 p.m.)
- As “swing editor” works with Senior Editor and News Director to set daily news agenda, and is responsible for updating copy, audio and promotional materials for both afternoon and morning news programs; as deputy to Senior Editor, serves as news editor for other WNPR reporters as assigned
- Produces web content for YourPublicMedia.org, including publishing of stories, features, copy, audio, video and photographs
- Responsible for communications with National Public Radio news and stations in regional news consortiums, through email, phone calls and daybook
- Operates remote recording equipment and produces field reports for same-day air
- Runs audio board and production equipment in conjunction with DAVID computer system and provides audio board, production, and David training to other staff members
- Serves as on-air fundraiser as needed
- Other duties as assigned.

**SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Minimum of bachelor’s degree with journalism major preferred; master’s degree desirable
- Five or more years of radio reporting experience, with public radio reporting and editing experience preferred
- Demonstrated national reporting skills — quality of work has been featured on NPR or other national radio services
- Five or more radio announcing experience, with ability to match public radio announcing style
- Demonstrated strong ability to write and edit news copy to NPR guidelines
- Ability to work successfully with editors and producers in team environment

- Demonstrated proficiency in digital editing, audio production, and web production techniques
- Demonstrated ability to meet tight deadlines and perform under pressure of live broadcasting
- Understanding of public radio “Core Values,” which inform WNPR’s programming choices.
